STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All Funeral Directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and let you compare prices between different Funeral Directors (because prices can vary).

Attended Funeral (Funeral Director's Charges Only)

£1850.00

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

- Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements £950.00
- Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death within a 20 mile radius of our premises into our care £100.00
- Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept in our Chapel of Rest £100.00
- Providing an Oak Veneer coffin with bar handles £250.00
- Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends by appointment with the Funeral Director (if required) £50.00
- Taking the deceased person to the agreed Cemetery or Crematorium within a 25 mile radius at a date and time agreed with you in our hearse with Funeral Director, Driver and our team of Pallbearers £400.00

Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony or service for the deceased person but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

- Burial (Funeral Director's Charges Only) £890.00
- Cremation (Funeral Director's Charges plus the Crematorium Fee) £995.00

Fees You Must Pay

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony or service for the deceased person but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

- For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee* £348.00- £519.00

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee is listed below, for a new grave you will also need to pay for the plot, for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay the removal/replacement cost. In addition, the Cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

- Cromer Cemetery £525.00
- Sheringham Cemetery £450.00
- Churchyards £819.00

- For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee** £1004.00 - £1224.00

In this local area, the typical cost of the cremation fee is listed below.

- Cromer Crematorium £995.00
- St. Faith's Crematorium £1060.00
- Breckland Crematorium £840.00

Additional Funeral Director Products and Services

This Funeral Director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

- Additional Mileage (price per mile) £1.50
- Additional Transfer of the deceased person's body (for example to their home or to a place of worship) £150.00
- Collection and Delivery of Ashes within a 15 mile radius £25.00
- Embalming £200.00
- Funeral Officiant (for example, a Celebrant or Minister of Religion) £220.00
- Services supplied outside of normal hours Prices on Request

The Funeral Director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some of the arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

* This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

** In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay the doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
